The system is designed for fast simple installation by teams of competent Habitat Technicians and to accommodate all types of hot work in hazardous areas (Zones 1 & 2).



Fully certified to ATEX, IECEx, DNV 2.7-2 & full NORSOK

- Constant monitoring of air flow & module pressure
- Internal and external gas detection, 4 off Hydrocarbon detectors & 2 off Hydrogen Sulphide detectors
- Internal heat detection
- 1 off ESD internally & 1 off ESD externally
- 1 off ESD Junction Box.
 This allows the systems shutdown system to be tied into the rig shutdown system

- Instant shutdown for dramatic loss of pressure e.g. should the habitat suffer a loss of pressure for any other reason apart from opening the door, it will shut down instantly
- All electrical components are dual certified (ATEX & IECEx)
- Sounder/beacon is activated on loss of pressure, overpressure, loss of flow, fire detection & gas detection
